Every month we will focus on an aspect of school life to share with our TPS Families.

United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)

We learn about the rights of the child every week through assembly and share them when appropriate and relevant in learning. There are 54 rights/ articles divided in to three themes of provision, protection and participation. The full UNCRC is quite wordy for primary school pupils and so we use wording like this to explain UNCRC Articles Archive - The Children and Young People's Commissioner Scotland (cypcs.org.uk) For example we ask pupils for their thoughts and opinions on subjects that affect them (article 12) This week in assembly we are

looking at article 2 and linking it to respect. See the slide below and ask your child about it.

UNCRC - SHANARRI

Every child has rights "without discrimination of any kind, irrespective of the child's or his or her parent's or legal guardian's race, colour, sex, language, religion, political or othe opinion, national, ethnic or social origin, property, disability, birth or other status" (Article 2).
