Learning in Term 4

Health and Wellbeing

We will use Bounceback to look at success, and how we can be successful. Through our farming topic we will also look at healthy eating and have a chance to try different fruits.

In PE the first part of this term will focus on getting ready for sports day practising races and activities we may do. To finish the term, we will focus on summer games.

Literacy

In Literacy we will continue to progress through the Rigby Star reading scheme for most, others will be beginning to work or continuing to work on novels. In phonics we will continue to learn new sounds, while consolidating our learning in previous sounds. We will also focus on being able to read and write our common words.

Our writing focus will continue with stories, while also looking at reports and instructional writing.

In Listening and talking will focus on improving our listening skills within all areas of learning.

Numeracy

We will start the term by finishing off multiplication and division. We will then move onto fractions where we will look at half and quarter. Miss Jones is going to focus on time this term with the class, and Miss Strachan will focus on money. At the end of the term, we will spend time on measure, looking at length and weight.

Other Curricular Areas

Our main topic this term will be Food and Farming. We will learn about types of farming, and about the process in how we get things from farms to our homes.

Homework

Homework will be issued on the Tuesday of each week and should be returned the following Monday in your child's homework jotter. Homework will comprise of maths, spelling and reading. Reading records will accompany guided reading books outlining what should be read at home. A reminder that homework is not issued on short weeks.

Notes
